## Who is it for?

Access is intended for those students who have not studied at this level before. It is ideal for learners who wish to progress on to Higher Education courses (degrees or higher diplomas) in subject areas such as:

- Nursing & Other Health professions
- Social Work
- Social Sciences
- Humanities
- Law
- Teaching
- Art & Design

## They are ideal for students that:

- Are returning to education
- Want fast-track progression to university
- Study full-time (1 year) or part-time (2 years)
- Want parent-friendly classes that run between 10.00am and 3.00pm
- Require full study skills and tutorial support

## What do I need to get in?

You must have GCSE English at grade C or better to enrol on the Access course. For many progression routes, GCSE Maths is also required and those wishing to progress into Primary Teaching must also have GCSE Science. The requirements for progression will be discussed at your initial guidance interview.

All applicants for the Access course will have an initial interview with a member of the careers guidance team, which will be followed by a short English and Maths assessment.

## How is it assessed?

The course is continually assessed through assignment work. The modes of assessment are specific to particular subjects. They are designed to allow students to meet all the relevant assessment criteria in a manner that is stimulating, relates to the type of assessment undertaken at HE level and where possible, addresses topical or vocational issues.

## How much will it cost?

- For most students, the full-time course is free of charge
- Adult Learner Grants may be available
